The **Master of Health Administration Online** program is designed to prepare part-time students with a minimum of two years of relevant healthcare management or clinical experience for management and leadership positions of increasing responsibility in healthcare organizations such as hospitals; managed care organizations; medical group practices; ambulatory, long-term care, insurance and pharmaceutical companies; consulting firms; government agencies; for-profit and nonprofit sector organizations.

In the final semester, prior to graduation, students engage in a culminating experience through the Integrative Capstone course. In this course students integrate the knowledge and skills acquired in the program to a "real world" experience that culminates in a project deliverable outside their typical scope of work.
